LIFE History



Everything started when former OCI president Kim Busl came together with his wife Joyce, to help strengthen VitaSalus, the newly formed wellness center located in the heart of Portugal.

Among other activities, Kim and Joyce organized classes for young people with the purpose of training them to become missionaries for life.

The program was deeply appreciated by students and was carried forward even after their departure. Thus, in 2017, under a new leadership and a more structured format, the course received a new name: the **LIFE Course**. LIFE is the acronym for **Lifestyle Intervention Faith Education**.

Today, the **LIFE** course trains young people to serve human kind in whatever setting and profession they may find themselves in. It is indeed a training for a better and more meaningful **LIFE!**

Ministry opportunities

The LIFE Course prepares you to:

Enrolment prerequisites

Prospective students must:

- Have a desire to serve God and people
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be fluent in English (verbally, reading and writing)
- Hold a High School diploma or equivalent

Classrom policies

- The use of electronic devices is dependent on the indication of the teacher, with the understanding that it is allowed for class purposes only.
- No food or beverages other than water is allowed in the classrooms
- Please keep the classroom neat and clean. No personal belongings are to be left behind in the classroom, as these will be removed daily.
- Since proper dress helps create an atmosphere for learning, students are expected to attend class with simple, modest, neat clothing.

Attendance policy

Worship / Vespers Attendance

While nothing can take the place of our personal devotions, daily worship is an important part of the spiritual health and unity of our school. Worship is a time when students come together to share, pray and study God's word. Students will be asked to participate and lead various aspects of these worships. Friday evening vespers starts at 20:00 during summer time and 19:30 during winter time.

Classes and Practical Work

Understanding that time is a precious talent we have received from God, our institution values punctuality and reliability. Students are expected to be on time and to maintain regular attendace and class participation. Three tardies will equal one unexcused absence. A lack of attentiveness may also be considered an absence. Students who miss more than 10% of class time (unexcused) will be assigned a failing grade.

Certificates

Certificates are earned by completing the requirements of each subject. Any certificates awarded are solely certificates of completion. They do not represent certification from any accrediting agency, state or national agency, or any other external body.

Finances

The total cost for the **15 week program training** is **2650** € (Taxes and **30** € Application Fee included). This price includes lodging, meals and tuition fees. It does not include costs related to the Mission trip. All students who are accepted into the program starting September 2024, are required to pay by Sept 1 a deposit of **300** € to secure their position in the training program.

There are two options of payment:

- 1. Full payment: the remaining 2320 € must be paid no later than September 5
- 2. Fractionated: 4 payments of 580 €
- First fee must be deposited by September 5
- Second fee must be deposited by October 5
- Third fee must be deposited by November 5
- Fourth fee must be deposited by December 5

After every deposit the student is expected to send a proof of the bank transfer to the school's e-mail address: **education@medicinapreventiva.pt**

Refund policies

Any application for a refund will be processed for students who present a written request cancelling or withdrawing their enrolment in the program, according to the rules listed below. Refunds will only be made available for unused fees.

- 1. Refunds will be considered in the case of cancellation / withdrawal from the program for justified reasons only.
- 2. Students who pay their fees in a fractionated way, can apply for a refund of unused fees, if a written request for cancelation/ withdrawal from the program reaches the course coordinator through e-mail, by the due date for the payment of that respective month fee.
- 3. Students who pay their fees in one payment, can apply for a refund of any unused fees if a written request for cancelation/ withdrawal reaches the course coordinator, through e-mail, by September 30, 2024. No requests for unused fees will be processed after that respective date.

Practical Work

Understanding that practical work is key for character development, all our students will serve in different departments of our institution by rotation, ensuring a complete and balanced experience. Our policy requires a commitment of 20 hours of work weekly, in an assigned position:

- Kitchen
- Housekeeping
- Organic Gardening
- Maintenance
- Lifestyle programs







Dorm & Student life

Dorm policies

- All rooms are expected to be clean and orderly. Roommates share equal responsability for the care and condition of their rooms and furnishings.
- Daily chores and Sabbath preparations should be done conscientiously
- Visitors of the opposite sex are not allowed in dormitory rooms at any time of the day/ night.
- Students must be on campus by 9:30 PM except there was any other agreement with the school director. We recommend students to go to bed on time, to be able to have strength and energy for the following day.
- Overnight/ weekend leaves must be approved by School Director. (Form must be completed)
- Each student will receive a key to lock their room. The key must be returned at the end of the course.
- Wireless Internet is available at the class room area. As the Internet is limited we ask you to use it only for school and communication purposes. Downloading content of any kind is not permitted.
- The APMP does not assume responsability for any lost, damaged or stolen personal proprety.



Laundry

Laundry facilities are available for students to use for free in their dormitory. We provide for the students simple laundry detergent and fabric softener. For any special wishes, the students are responsible to provide for themselves. The washing machine is not to be used during Sabbath hours (sundown Friday until sundown Saturday) and also between 9 pm - 6 am during work days.

Cafeteria

A plant-based breakfast, lunch and dinner are served in the Student Cafeteria seven days a week.

- The student Cafeteria is open for breakfast at 7:30-8:00 AM on week days and 8:00 AM on weekends.
- Lunch is served at 1:00 PM (1:30 PM during programs).
- Only authorized kitchen staff are allowed in the kitchen areas at all times.

Sabbath Ministry

We have a necessity of maintaining service during the Sabbath hours at the Dinning room: both staff and students are required to participate in this special ministry. This helps relieve those who serve in the department during the week and need suitable periodic relief from their duties. Jesus Himself lived among men "as He that served" and indicated that it was lawful to do well on the Sabbath.

If you do not know how to perform your duty, please check with the department supervisor a day or two ahead of time so you can be trained appropriately.

Car policy

Mission trip

Students will have the opportunity to benefit a community in the world and put into practice their new learned skills during a Mission Trip, planned for 2024. Portugal, Morocco, Tunisia, Azores Islands and Romania are among the possible destinations.

Costs related with the Mission Trip are not covered by the tuition fees. Our plan is to organize a campaign to collect funds that will help students cover most of the trip's expenses.









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
